

## Conducting Company Research: Business Task Cards Activity – Print Version

### Instruction Activity:

Discuss the four task cards to help students locate company information, including company profiles, financials, and articles. The activity may be conducted on the individual level or in teams.

1. Assign students to teams (if applicable)
2. Give students task card #1 (5-10 minutes)
3. Demonstrate 1 library resource for the specific task (5-10 minutes)
4. Repeats steps 2 and 3 for the remaining task cards

Alternatively, you can assign specific tasks to specific teams then review all four tasks as a group.

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### Research Approach:

#### Task Card #1:

*Discussion:* What resource did you find for company information?

Demonstrate a database that provides general company information and/or company profiles. (e.g. LexisNexis Company Dossier, Business Insights, etc.)

**Task Card #2:**

*Discussion:* What resource did you find for company financials?

Demonstrate a database that provides company financials. (e.g. Morningstar Investment Research Center, Mergent Online, etc.)

**Task Card #3:**

*Discussion:* What resource did you use to find articles?

Demonstrate a database that provides business articles. (e.g. Business Source Complete, ABI/INFORM Collection, etc.)

**Task Card #4:**

*Discussion:* What resource did you use to locate industry trends?

Demonstrate a database that provides industry information and/or industry news. (e.g. IBISWorld, Business Source Complete, etc.)

### Instruction Activity:

Discuss the three task cards (Google Forms) to help students locate company information, including company profiles, financials, and articles. The activity may be conducted on the individual level or in teams.
